Jumbo Concrete Blocks

As we remembered the tragedy of 9/11 with a 10th Anniversary Memorial Service for all our local first responders on September 11th, 2011 here at our church, we became increasingly aware of our vulnerability. Specifically, vehicles were being used to cause harm at that time around the world; and recently, vehicles are again becoming an easy means of causing major trouble.

At that 10th Anniversary Memorial Service, we parked the visiting fire trucks along the service road by the level grass area and the handicap ramp to deny access to our terrace and main entry by any vehicles. Since that time, during significant events, we have blocked that area off using varying means. Just before the Christmas season, we began using jumbo concrete blocks there for the safety of all who come to worship with us.

Soon, those blocks will be replaced with an attractive rock garden using varying size rocks and plantings. When the *Paving the Pathway* project is complete, we will have a beautiful terrace and main entry area permanently inaccessible to any vehicles except by prior arrangement. Check out the photos on the *Vision for the Generations* brochure and poster in the foyer.

In these troubling times, we are comforted by Scripture and are reminded to be vigilant and prepared as written in Proverbs 21:31:
