Well Done, Good & Faithful Servant

Lorrie Doris Anderson, one of our faithful missionaries, was welcomed Home by her Lord, Jesus, on Monday, October 26th. On October 6th, 1948, Lorrie landed at the airport in Lima, Peru, South America to begin her life's work as a Bible translator with co-worker Doris Cox. After studying the language and culture in Lima for a number of months, the women left for the jungle base at Yarinacocho. In 1950, they made contact with the Shapra Indians, a headhunting tribe near the border of Ecuador. Because the Lord planned their work, the chief of this tribe gave Lorrie and Doris permission to live among his people. Chief Tariri trusted Jesus as his Savior as did many of the men, women, and children of his tribe. Thirty years later, the women presented the Shapra and Candoshi people with the New Testament in their own language! These people would not have had the Word of God were it not for Lorrie's servant's heart and your support—prayer and financial—for over her 65 years of service. Our Christian love is given to her niece, Jennifer (Drew) Langford, and to her nephew, Chris Drew.
